

Application Requirements

1. Application

- ①An applicant must complete 12 years of school education and meet all the requirements below.
- ②An applicant has to have clear vision and direction for the future.
- ③An applicant has to complete 150 hours of study hours in a Japanese language institute OR Japanese language certificate of N5 or higher is required.
- ④Should be able to afford tuition and living expenses in Japan.
- ⑤It has to be within less than 5 years from last educational background.
- ⑥An applicant has to be healthy mentally and physically.
- ⑦ Respect and follow all the rules and laws in Japan,

2. Application period

- April Admission: September 1st ~October 20th.
- October Admission: April 1st ~May 20th

※Application entry might close as it reaches the admission capacity of students.

3. Classes Schedule

- Morning Class 9:00~12 : 50 (50min) 5Days/Week (Mon~Fri)
- Afternoon Class 14:00~17:50 (50min) 5Days/Week (Mon~Fri)

School closes on Saturdays/Sundays/Holidays

Holidays/Vacations in March-April, August, December-January

We offer two class sections; class hours depend on which class you are in.

Application fee should be made when you apply for admission.

Enrollment fee and tuition for the first term (1st year) should be made within two weeks after the school informs.

Others on the list include text books, transportation fee, school events/activities fees.

As soon as payment is confirmed, acceptance letter and certificate eligibility will be sent to a student.

① Facility

Students share the dormitory together. A refrigerator, a rice cooker, a gas stove, a washing machine, and a table are already equipped in the dorm. The school will offer futons to students as well.

② Water and electricity fee are not included in dormitory fee. Students split the bill and pay themselves each month.

③ Choosing the room and roommates are not allowed by themselves. Room assignment will be done in the order students enter Japan.

④ If you don't follow the rules of dormitory (making noise, not proper way to dispose the trash, not parking the bicycles properly, getting complains from the neighbor/owner, breaking facility, home electronics, wet areas such as kitchen and sink in a bathroom.)

You will be asked to move out if you don't follow the rules.

⑤ A room key should be kept by individual student. Fine must be paid on loss of key.

⑥ Please bring a key back to school when moving out an apartment. Fine must be paid on loss of key or not returning.

① Minimum deposit amount that you need is on the list above. If there is something which needed to be changed such as health insurance or price of JLPT, you will need to pay for on your own.

② Students are required to take JLPT.

③ If there is any unpaid bill for water, electricity, any breakage to fix, leaving personal stuff in an apartment, payment will be made from the security deposit in those cases and remaining amount of deposit will be

refunded after. However, if security deposit is not enough to cover, you might need to pay extra fee to pay them off.

- ④ You are required to purchase international students insurance in order to live with security in Japan. The insurance covers accidents, injuries, illness (medical bill.)

The insurance is included in the invoice.

There are some coverage exceptions, so if you have any questions, please contact us.

7. Refund Policies (Tuition)

- ① An application fee is non-refundable even if an application is either rejected or enrollment is cancelled.

- ② Visa Denial

If visa application is refused, an applicant needs to send an acceptance letter, proof of visa denial to the school in order to receive refund.

Admission fee, application fee, the dorm fee (up until the day the school receives the letter of acceptance and official proof of visa denial), cancellation charge of the dorm (for one month), handling fee of the matter, and remittance charge will be deducted from the total amount, and the remaining amount will be refunded to a recipient's bank account within 50 days from the day the school receives those required documents.

- ③ Declining admission regarding personal matter

If an enrollment is canceled due to his/her own issues or personal matters even before receiving a result from the embassy, acceptance letter and the proof of visa revocation must be sent to the school in order for an applicant to receive refund. Admission fee, application fee, the dorm fee (up until the day the school receives those documents), and cancellation charge of the dorm (for one month), handling fee of the matter, and remittance charge will be deducted from the total amount. Remaining amount will be refunded to a recipient's bank account within 50 days from the day school receives documents.

④ Withdraw before completing courses

If you stay in school for more than a year and decide to continue education in other institutes or to start working before you complete a course, you need to notify and submit a school withdrawal form two months before you actually plan to withdraw. If withdrawal form is approved, we will pay the balance of tuition back.

⑤ Moving out from a student dormitory

You must stay in a student dorm for at least one year since you enter the school. After one year, you can move out if you want to. To move out, you need to notify and submit moving out notification 2 months before the day you actually plan to move out an apartment. If moving notification is approved and still have balance of dormitory fee, we will give you the balance of dormitory fee (following months) back to you.

⑥ Deposit

If there is any deposit balance left, we will give it back to you within 50 days after you graduate or withdraw from school.

⑦ The following cases are non-refundable

The list below is nonrefundable even though you submit school withdrawal form to school.

- 1) Breaking the rules and laws in Japan.
- 2) Transferring to another school/institute.
- 3) Getting Married.
- 4) Getting Pregnant

⑧ Remittance charge

Remittance fee will be covered by a student.

⑨ Exceptional reasons for withdrawal

If there are some exceptional reasons for withdrawal, the matter will be discussed individually.
